You will take part in movement, dance, sound, film and projection workshops.

You will make a film installation for Watford Museum for the general public to come and see.



WHEN WILL IT TAKE PLACE?:

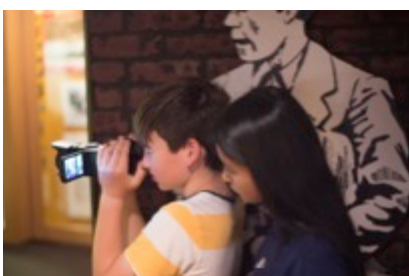
Workshops: Tuesday 28 May, Wednesday 29 May and Thursday 30 May 2019, 10am – 4pm each day
